Govt agencies more ICT-savvy

GOVERNMENT agencies are improving their work flow with greater use of information and communications technology, a government official said.

They want to partner with suitable companies to come up with the right solutions, Public

Service Department Malaysia director Dr Aminuddin Hashim said.

Aminuddin said most government agencies and ministries are looking at increasing their ICT usage and are on the lookout for the ideal partner to come up with a customised solution.

"Despite getting RM4 billion

for ICT in the 9th Malaysian Plan, we still haven't achieved total ICT implementation in the government sector as we need more funds to do so," he said in an interview with the Business Times in conjunction with the National ICT conference from October 11 to 12 at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre yesterday.
